



Cash for Education Program

Supporting school attendance of children of vulnerable households through provision of an education cash top-up

Program objective	To support the inclusion of refugee children in learning (face-to-face and remote) in the new school year 2022/2023.
Tools of the program	A conditional cash assistance is provided to through MoneyGram and Visa cards.
Beneficiary selection criteria of beneficiaries of the program	<p>The programme is designed for vulnerable Ukrainian displaced households affected by the crisis with children from 3-17, regardless of whether these children are enrolled in the formal or non-formal education and care system in Slovakia (distance or present mode) in the new school year 2022/2023. This programme is only for the most vulnerable pre-selected households that have already participated in Emergency Financial Assistance from the Red Cross; therefore, no new registrations are unfortunately possible.</p> <p>Preselection criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a. Households with children at school age (between 3-17 years old)b. Single headed households with childrenc. Household with person with special needsd. Elderly headed households caring for children. e.g grandson/granddaughter
Assistance amount	A grant of 120 € will be given per child aged between 3-17 years old registered by IFRC/SRC (1,779 children) enrolled in Emergency Financial Assistance.
Duration	The grant is a one-time payment of 120 EUR which will be provided in late October 2022.
